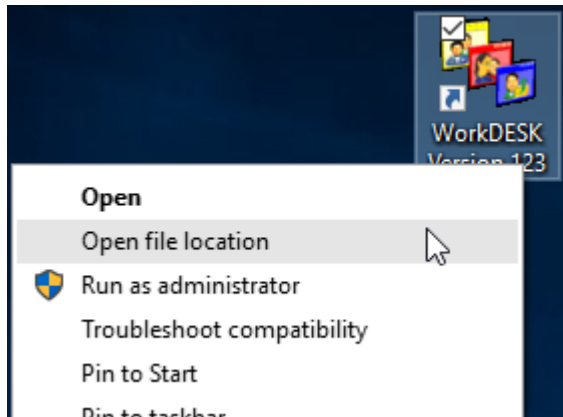
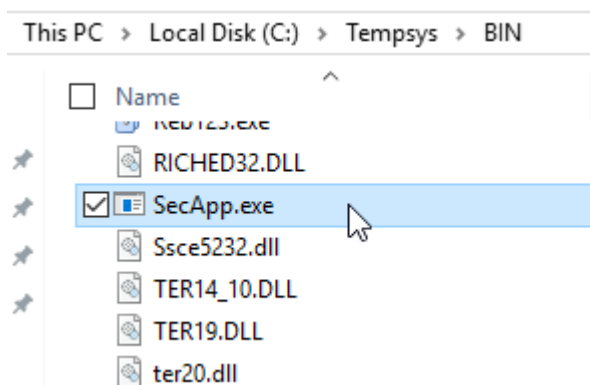


WorkDESK Security Check with SecApp.exe

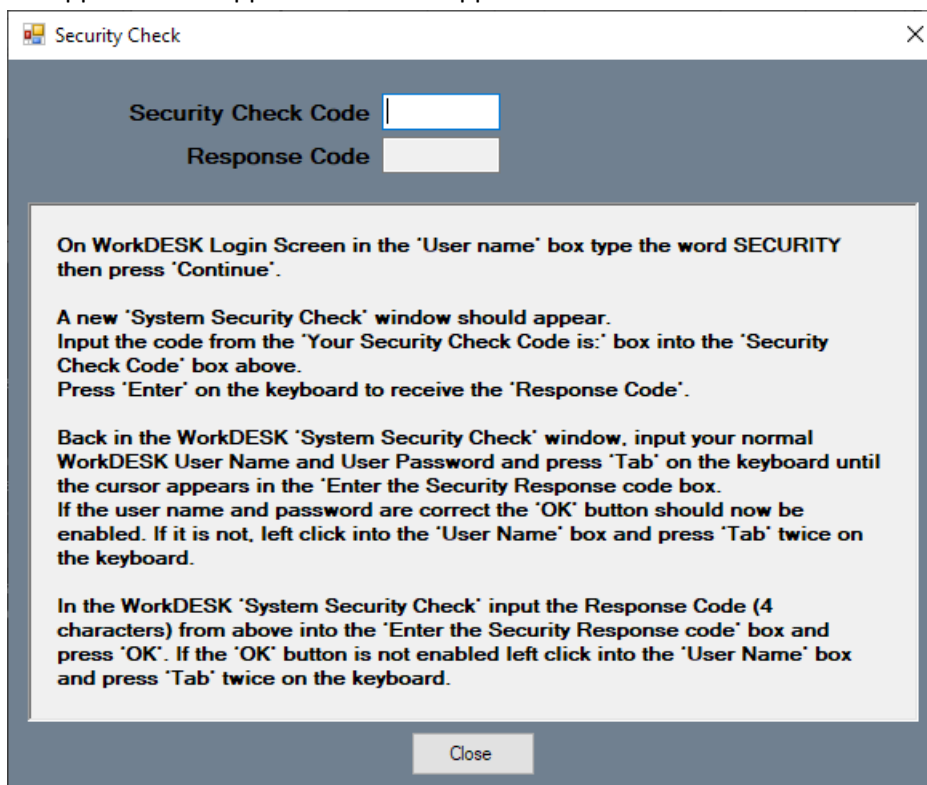
Locate and run the SecApp.exe in your Tempsys\Bin directory




Right click on your WorkDESK icon and select 'Open file location'



Find the 'SecApp.exe' and double click - this will require that you have downloaded and installed SecApp.exe – the application should appear similar to this:




On WorkDESK Login Screen in the 'User name' box type the word SECURITY then press 'Continue'.







If the user name and password are correct the 'OK' button should now be enabled. If it is not, left click into the 'User Name' box and press 'Tab' twice on the keyboard.

If the 'OK' button is not enabled left click into the 'User Name' box and press 'Tab' twice on the keyboard.
